

Our Boarding Policies

To ensure that your pet's stay is comfortable and enjoyable, we ask that you observe the following policies:

- Mark all of your pet's accompanying belongings with a permanent marker.
 - Please limit toys to a maximum of two that are softball size or larger.
 - You may bring your own food for your pet but bring only enough for your pet's stay with us, as we do not have storage space for large bags of food.

Additional things to consider when bringing your pet to board at Union Lake Pet Services:

- Because of all the activity surrounding them, most pets do not play with the toys you send with them.
 - Our staff loves animals, so you can rest assured your pet's needs will be met with care and concern.
 - Our service includes keeping fresh, clean bedding and dishware in your pet's boarding space, so we ask that you not bring bedding for your pet.

Required Pet Vaccinations to Board

Dogs

- Rabies
- Distemper
- Distemper Combo vaccine
- Bordetella vaccine every six months for canine cough
- Annual negative heartworm test
- Twice-annual negative intestinal parasite screening.

We strongly recommend, but do not require, an up to date canine influenza vaccination for your pet.

Cats

- Rabies
 - Distemper
 - Feline leukemia test or vaccine
 - Intestinal parasite screen

Fecals (intestinal parasite screen)—Are required within six months of boarding at Union Lake Pet Services. If one has not been done prior to entry, we will do one during your pet's stay and immediately treat any parasites we find.
